Utility Systems & Applications (US&A) is recruiting for part-time and full-time journeyman metermen.

The purpose of this recruitment is to develop a list of qualified journeyman metermen from which positions can be filled in the next six to twelve months. Both working and retired qualified journeyman metermen are welcome to apply.

#### About US&A

US&A has been performing metering services for electric utilities since 1980. US&A has withstood the test of time in the competitive marketplace. US&A performs services on both a project basis and under long-term service agreements.

US&A's metering services projects range from days to years. Most of the project work is part-time, although the longer-term projects can offer full-time employment for years.

US&A's qualified journeyman technicians have completed shop testing and calibration services, comprehensive field evaluations of metering installations and long-term AMR deployment for commercial and industrial accounts.

US&A also enters in to long-term metering services agreements with utilities. US&A's metermen may work alongside utility metermen, performing all of the work assigned to the meter department. These service agreements tend to be longer term and may extend over several months or even several years, with the metermen assigned to the utility.

#### Service Area

Although US&A has worked primarily in the Pacific Northwest (Oregon, Washington, and Alaska), it has also completed electric metering services in other parts of the country and anticipates new opportunities in all geographic areas.

#### Working Arrangements

US&A employs metermen for contracted part-time and full time metering services for utilities.

When opportunities arise, US&A will contact metermen in its recruitment pool based on their qualifications, the geographic areas where they would like to work, and their interests in part-time or full-time work. Work schedules and other arrangements are generally flexible.

#### Compensation

US&A is proudly affiliated with IBEW and offers union scale journeyman meterman hourly rates. Retirees, who already have benefits, may receive compensation in-lieu of benefits.

#### Qualifications

- Experience in electrical metering services for utility revenue metering and current journeyman-level qualifications.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently, with strong supporting references.
- Strong oral and written communication skills, with emphasis on customer service.
- Proficiency in the use of personal computers and meter programming hardware and software.
- A valid driver's license and acceptable driving record. Criminal record checks and Drug and Alcohol testing may also be required.
